## **Emiri Decree No. (4) of 2020**

### **Concerning**

### **Service Fees and Fines Applied by the Local Police in the Emirate of Ajman**

We, Ammar bin Humaid Al Nuaimi, Crown Prince of the Emirate of Ajman

Having reviewed Federal Decree-Law No. (26) of 2019 concerning the Public Finance of the State,

And Emiri Decree No. (11) of 2011 issuing the Financial Law of the Government of Ajman and its executive regulations,

And Emiri Decree No. (4) of 2013 concerning the Local Police in the Emirate of Ajman,

And Emiri Decree No. (4) of 2014 concerning the reorganization of the Executive Council of the Emirate of Ajman and its amendments,

And Emiri Decree No. (1) of 2017 concerning the establishment of the Security Services Support Authority in Ajman,

And Emiri Decree No. (2) of 2018 concerning the Legislation Committee in the Emirate of Ajman,

And Emiri Decree No. (1) of 2019 concerning Fees, Taxes, and Fines in the Emirate of Ajman,

And Cabinet Resolution No. (30) of 2017 concerning Traffic and Road Safety Services,

And Emiri Decree No. (6) of 2015 concerning the local service fees and fines applied by the Ajman Police,

And Emiri Decree No. (26) of 2017 concerning the local service fees and fines applied by the Security Services Support Authority in Ajman and its amendments,

And based on the approval of the Legislation Committee,

We have issued the following Decree:

## **Article (1)**

### **Adoption of Fees**

The Local Police in the Emirate of Ajman shall collect the fees specified for each of the services listed in Schedule No. (1) attached to this Decree.

## **Article (2)**

### **Recording Violations, Imposing and Collecting Fines**

- a. The Local Police in the Emirate of Ajman shall be responsible for recording and proving the violations stipulated in Schedule No. (2) attached to this Decree, and for imposing and collecting the prescribed fine for the violation.
- b. In addition to the fine stipulated in Schedule No. (2) attached to this Decree, the Commander-in-Chief of Ajman Police, or his authorized representative, may, in the event of a repeated violation, take any of the following measures against the violator:
  - 1. Closing the violating establishment for a period not exceeding (30) days.
  - 2. Revoking the permit issued by the Local Police.
  - 3. Addressing the competent authority to revoke the license.
- c. A permit issued by the Local Police to an establishment may not be renewed before all fines due from the establishment under this Decree have been paid.

## **Article (3)**

### **Grievance**

The violator may submit a written grievance to the Commander-in-Chief of Ajman Police, or his authorized representative, within (15) days from the date of notification of the violation, decision, action, or measure being grieved. The grievance shall be decided upon within (30) days from the date of its submission by a committee formed by the Commander-in-Chief for this purpose. The decision forming the committee shall specify its working mechanism.

## **Article (4)**

### **Devolution of Revenues**

The proceeds of the fees and fines collected under the provisions of this Decree shall be transferred to the account of the Public Treasury of the Government of Ajman.

## Article (5)

### Cancellations

Emiri Decree No. (6) of 2015 concerning the local service fees and fines applied by the Ajman Police is hereby repealed, as is any text or provision in any other decree that contradicts or conflicts with the provisions of this Decree.

## Article (6)

### Entry into Force and Publication

This Decree shall come into force 30 days after the date of its issuance and shall be published in the Official Gazette.
