

Amiri Decision No. (26) of 2017

Regarding Local Service Fees and Fines Applied by the Security Services Support Authority in Ajman

We, Ammar bin Humaid Al Nuaimi, Crown Prince of Ajman, Chairman of the Executive Council.

After reviewing Federal Law No. (1) of 2011 regarding the State's Public Revenues;

And Amiri Decree No. (4) of 2003 regarding the Fund for Local Fees for Special Services and Fines for Violating Public Order in Ajman;

And Amiri Decree No. (2) of 2016 regarding the restructuring of the Executive Council of the Emirate of Ajman;

And Amiri Decree No. (11) of 2011 issuing the Financial Law of the Government of Ajman and its executive regulations;

And Amiri Decree No. (4) of 2013 regarding the Local Police in the Emirate of Ajman;

And Amiri Decision No. (16) of 2017 regarding the local service fees and fines applied by the Local Police in the Emirate of Ajman;

And for the public interest;

We have issued the following Amiri Decree:

Article (1)

Name of the Decision

This Decision shall be named "Amiri Decision No. (26) of 2017 regarding Local Service Fees and Fines Applied by the Security Services Support Authority in Ajman" and shall come into effect from the first day of January 2018.

Article (2)

Determination and Collection of Local Fees

The Security Services Support Authority in Ajman shall charge the local fees specified in List No. (1) attached to this Amiri Decision and shall collect them in exchange for the services it provides to the beneficiaries of those services.

Article (3)

Control of Violations and Imposition and Collection of Fines

The Security Services Support Authority in Ajman is competent to control and prove the violations specified in List No. (2) attached to this Amiri Decision, and it is entrusted with imposing and collecting the prescribed fine for each of them, for the benefit of the aforementioned Authority to dispose of it in accordance with the provisions of local legislation and financial systems in force in the Government of Ajman.

Article (4)

Repeal of Conflicting Provisions

As of the effective date of this Amiri Decision, any provision contained in any Amiri decision in effect in the Emirate of Ajman at the time of the entry into force of this Decision, which contradicts the provisions contained in this Amiri Decision, shall be repealed to the extent that may be required to remove the conflict between the relevant provision and the provisions of this Amiri Decision.

Article (5)

Publication of the Decision

This Amiri Decision shall be published in the Official Gazette of the Emirate and circulated to all concerned parties to act accordingly, each within its own jurisdiction.
