Amiri Decision No. (5) of 2017

Concerning Public Hygiene Service Fees in Ajman and Related Violation Fines

We, Ammar bin Humaid Al Nuaimi, Crown Prince of Ajman, Chairman of the Ajman Executive Council,

Having reviewed Amiri Decree No. (5) of 2002 regarding transaction fees at the Ajman Municipality;

And Amiri Decree No. (14) of 2006 regarding the reorganization of the Department of Municipality and Planning in Ajman;

And Amiri Decree No. (11) of 2011 issuing the Financial Law of the Government of Ajman and its executive regulations;

And Amiri Decree No. (10) of 2014 regarding the establishment of the Central Administration for Legal Affairs;

And Amiri Decree No. (1) of 2015 regarding the Department of Economic Development; and Amiri Decision No. (12) of 2015 regarding the service fees of the Department of Economic Development in Ajman;

And Amiri Decree No. (2) of 2017 issuing the Real Estate Rental Law in the Emirate of Ajman;

And in pursuit of the public interest...

Have decided to issue the following Amiri Decision:

Article (1)

Name of the Decision and its Entry into Force

This Decision shall be named "Amiri Decision No. (5) of 2017, concerning Public Hygiene Service Fees in Ajman and Related Violation Fines" and shall come into force starting from the first day of March 2017.

Article (7)

Repeal of Previous Legislations

As of the effective date of this Amiri Decision, any text or provision contained in any local legislation currently in force in the Emirate that contradicts or conflicts with the provisions of this Amiri Decision shall be repealed.

Article (8)

Publication and Circulation of the Amiri Decision

This Decision shall be published in the Official Gazette of the Emirate and circulated to all concerned authorities to act accordingly, each within its jurisdiction.

1	Obstructing cleaning operations or obstructing an inspector from performing their duties	1000
2	Disposing of small quantities of waste - such as throwing or leaving food scraps and consumables - in places not designated for them	500
3	Disposing of a light vehicle load of waste in places not designated for it	5,000
4	Disposing of a heavy vehicle load of waste in places not designated for it	20,000
5	Failure to take necessary measures to prevent the scattering or leakage of materials loaded in vehicles, such as covering transported sand or the opening of a concrete mixer truck	1,000
6	Leakage of loaded materials from vehicles	2,000
7	Burning waste	5000
8	Damaging small-sized plastic containers (less than 500 liters)	300
9	Damaging medium-sized containers (from 500 to 1100 liters)	1,500
