

Law No. (3) of 2004
Concerning
Imposing a Departure Fee via Dubai International Airport
We, Maktoum bin Rashid Al Maktoum

Having reviewed the Order Establishing the Department of Civil Aviation dated March 18, 1971,

We resolve to issue the following Law:

Article (1)

This Law shall be named "The Dubai International Airport Departure Fee Law No. (3) of 2004".

Article (2)

(1) A departure fee of thirty dirhams shall be collected from every passenger departing the Emirate of Dubai via Dubai International Airport to a destination outside the United Arab Emirates.

(2) Exempted from the provisions of the preceding paragraph are passengers under the age of two, and aircraft pilots and crew while on duty.

Article (3)

The proceeds from the departure fee mentioned in the preceding Article shall be allocated to the Department of Civil Aviation.

Article (4)

Airlines operating at Dubai International Airport shall be responsible for collecting this fee upon issuing travel tickets to their customers, whether

inside or outside the United Arab Emirates, and these companies must transfer the proceeds of the said fee to the Department of Civil Aviation.

Article (5)

The President of the Department of Civil Aviation shall issue the executive regulations for this Law.

Article (6)

This Law shall be published in the Official Gazette and shall come into effect as of the first day of September 2004.
