

Decree No. (27) of 2019
Concerning
The Reduction and Exemption of Certain Fees and Fines in the
Emirate of Dubai

We, Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum Ruler of Dubai

After reviewing the Dubai Municipal Revenues Law issued on 11 April 1961,
and the resolutions and instructions issued pursuant thereto,

And Law No. (13) of 2008 Concerning the Regulation of the Interim Real
Estate Register in the Emirate of Dubai and its amendments,

And Law No. (1) of 2016 Concerning the Financial System of the
Government of Dubai,

And Decree No. (24) of 2007 Forming the Supreme Committee for Financial
Policy in the Emirate of Dubai and its amendments, hereinafter referred to
as the "Supreme Committee",

And Regulation No. (2) of 2006 Concerning the Municipality Fee on Sales of
Hotel Establishments in the Emirate of Dubai,

And Executive Council Resolution No. (6) of 2010 Approving the
Implementing Bylaw of Law No. (13) of 2008 Concerning the Regulation of
the Interim Real Estate Register in the Emirate of Dubai,

And Executive Council Resolution No. (30) of 2013 Concerning the Approval
of Fees of the Land Department,

And Executive Council Resolution No. (50) of 2015 Concerning the
Regulation of Training Institutes in the Emirate of Dubai,

And Executive Council Resolution No. (4) of 2017 Approving Certain Fees
and Fines of the Dubai Civil Aviation Authority,

We decree the following:

Reduction of Fees

Article (1)

- a- The market fee imposed on economic establishments in the Emirate of Dubai under the aforementioned Dubai Municipality Revenues Law is reduced by (50%).
- b- The municipality fee imposed on the sales of hotel establishments under the aforementioned Regulation No. (2) of 2006 is reduced to become (7%) instead of (10%).
- c- The fees imposed on training institutes under the aforementioned Executive Council Resolution No. (50) of 2015 are reduced as specified in Schedule No. (1) attached to this Decree.
- d- The Supreme Committee will determine the economic establishments to be covered by the reduction stipulated in paragraph (a) of this Article, the effective date of the reduction stipulated in paragraph (b) of this Article, and the duration of the reduction stipulated in paragraph (c) of this Article.

Exemption from Dubai Civil Aviation Authority Fees

Article (2)

a- The following categories are exempted from the fees prescribed in favour of the Dubai Civil Aviation Authority under the aforementioned Executive Council Resolution No. (4) of 2017, as specified in Schedule No. (2) attached to this Decree:

- 1- Establishments and activities located in the Free Zone at Al Maktoum International Airport.
- 2- Private aircraft at Al Maktoum International Airport.

b- The duration of the exemption prescribed under paragraph (a) of this Article will be (3) three years, renewable by a decision of the Supreme Committee.

Real Estate Transaction Registration Fees

Article (3)

The fee imposed under the aforementioned Executive Council Resolution No. (30) of 2013 on the transfer of property ownership will be collected only once for properties whose purchase is financed through any form of Islamic financing, in accordance with the standards and controls approved by the Supreme Committee in this regard.

Exemption from Fines

Article (4)

a- Anyone who has not registered real estate transactions with the Land Department and paid the prescribed fees before the effective date of this Decree will be exempted from the fine prescribed under the aforementioned Executive Council Resolution No. (6) of 2010 and Executive Council Resolution No. (30) of 2013, provided that they complete the registration and pay the fees within the deadlines specified in Schedule No. (3) attached to this Decree and according to the exemption percentages specified for each.

b- The duration of the fine exemption prescribed under paragraph (a) of this Article is one year, starting from the effective date of this Decree.

Validity of Previous Exemptions and Reductions

Article (5)

All exemptions and reductions made on any of the fees or fines covered by the provisions of this Decree from 6 June 2018 until its effective date are deemed valid.

Commencement and Publication

Article (6)

This Decree comes into force on the date of its issuance and will be published in the Official Gazette.
